To complete the experience, try your hand at Mongolian archery and dress in traditional clothing for a memorable cultural moment.

KARAKORUM > ULAANBAATAR

Then, make your way to **Sukhbaatar Square**, the heart of Ulaanbaatar, where grand state ceremonies and cultural events take place—it's also where visiting dignitaries pay tribute to Mongolia's revolutionary hero, Sükhbaatar. As the sun sets, immerse yourself in a traditional folk concert featuring Mongolia's distinctive art forms, a fitting finale to a day filled with culture, history, and national pride.

DAY 03

KARAKORUM > ELSEN TASARKHAI

(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Begin the day with a visit to Erdenezuu, one of the oldest and most revered Buddhist monasteries in Mongolia, offering a serene window into the country's spiritual roots. Then journey toward Turtle Rock-a striking natural formation shaped entirely by wind and rain into the form of a turtle—set against landscapes so scenic they've earned the nickname "the Switzerland of Mongolia." Enjoy opportunities for hiking, and for the adventurous, horse or camel riding. At the Karakorum Museum, dive into Mongolia's rich past through fascinating artifacts from empires and dynasties that once ruled the land. Continue to Khaadiin Khad Hill for sweeping panoramic views of the Orkhon River Valley, before arriving at Elsen Tasarkhai, a unique stretch of sand dunes known as the "mini Gobi," where camel riding across golden dunes offers peaceful, unforgettable desert experience.

DAY 05


ULAANBAATAR > TERELJ NATIONAL PARK

Begin the day with a visit to the Chinggis Khan Statue Complex, home to the world's largest equestrian statue of Genghis Khan—an awe-inspiring tribute to Mongolia's legendary leader. Explore the museum within the complex, then head up to the statue's horse mane for an impressive panoramic view of the vast Mongolian steppe. Later, indulge in a traditional Mongolian lamb barbeque known as Khorkhog, where tender cuts of meat are cooked with vegetables and piping hot stones in a metal pot—a hearty and authentic way to end the day.

Today begins with a peaceful walk up the hills to the **Ariyapal Meditation Temple**, where a 30-minute scenic hike rewards you with stunning views of the surrounding valley and a sense of calm that lingers long after you arrive. Afterwards, visit the historic **Rock Turtle** sculptures, once guardians of ancient Karakorum's borders and symbols of eternity. These stone turtles, which originally held inscribed stelae on their backs, stand as quiet reminders of the city's deep-rooted past and the enduring spirit of Mongolia.

DAY 07



Continue to Zaisan Memorial Hill to honor the memory of Mongolian and Soviet soldiers from World War II, and pass by Buddha Park to admire the impressive 18-metre golden Sakyamuni statue. At the Bogd Khaan Palace, step back in time to explore former imperial residence Mongolia's last theocratic ruler. In the afternoon, take a more relaxed pace and Ulaanbaatar's vibrant city life—shop for natural skincare at Lhamour, browse luxurious Gobi cashmere at Galleria Ulaanbaatar, and pick up unique handmade souvenirs at the State Department Store. Then, cap off the evening with a comforting meal at The Bull Hot Pot, Mongolia's first and most beloved hot pot restaurant. Whether you're seeking history, shopping, or simply soaking up the city vibe, today's all about enjoying Úlaanbaátar your wáy.


